We envision a world where artists are valued and cared for. We create spaces that center artists and seek to provide access, agency, and opportunities for growth.

We envision communities that are not only LGBTIA+, *but queer.* Queerness as we define it is loving community, playfulness, joy, upending hierarchies, and collective liberation.

We know that Black, Indigenous, and POC queer and trans resistance has made our existence possible. We honor those queer ancestors by being accountable to one another, celebrating our survival, and fashioning the tools we need to build a world where we are most free.
